## **Back To Nature**

#### **EXPLORE OUR PARKS**

Outdoor adventure is always close by in Virginia Beach's state parks, with thousands of acres of protected forest, marsh and shoreline to explore. From guided tours to primitive campsites, ocean's edge to coastal forest, experience nature's best at Back Bay National Wildlife Refuge, False Cape State Park and First Landing State Park.





With 35 miles of ocean and bay beaches, more than 121 navigable miles of waterways and over 130,000 acres of natural area throughout Virginia Beach, nature's wonder is all around you. It's easy to explore the elements here, with outfitters and guided excursions to lead the way.

#### ON THE WATER

Don't be deceived by Virginia Beach's calm waters – there are plenty of thrills to be had here. On an ocean-going wildlife excursion, you can regularly catch sight of dolphins, birds and other aquatic life, including the occasional sea turtles or rays. In winter months, you have a chance to spy the thrill of a lifetime as humpback, fin and minke whales migrate through our waters. You can even paddle out off the beach for ocean kayaking with dolphins. Local outfitters will point you to the scores of inland waterways of area parks and wildlife refuges and provide the gear and instruction you need. Whether you surf, kayak

or paddleboard, the feeling of being one with the water is addictive.

#### ON THE SHORE

The unique coastal environment in Virginia Beach is a shared treasure and yours to explore thanks to an abundance of public parks. Sandbridge, Back Bay National Wildlife Refuge and False Cape State Park provide access to acres of marshland, forests, wildlife habitats and pristine beaches, with numerous trails you can hike or bike to remote locations. Along the Chesapeake Bay, First Landing State Park is a popular spot for nature walks, bike rides, camping and more - 19 miles of trails lead you through dense forests to cypress-filled lagoons and marshes.

#### IN THE TREES

Nature lends itself for high-flying adventure on the grounds of the Virginia Aquarium. Test your skills on the rope courses, platforms and ziplines high in the trees of The Adventure Park, where a variety of skill level challenges make the experience a blast for all ages. With safety instruction and gear provided, including double -clipped-on harness technology keeping climbers continuously connected to a safety cable, you'll be working your way through thirteen self-quided treetop trails with 170 crossings on your way to bragging rights.
