Feel the excitement and create memories as you climb, swing and zip line through the trees at The Adventure Park at Virginia Aquarium. The park offers 13 treetop trails through seven acres of maritime forest. Put on a full-body harness and use state-of-the-art climbing gear that keeps you always locked on to safety cables while you trek through the canopy. Trails are color-coded for every ability level – beginners to experts ages 5 to adult. These trails include unique bridges, tunnels, swings, and zip lines that connect platforms built at different heights in the trees. The lowest trails are about 10 feet high and the highest are 55 feet above the ground. Enjoy outdoor fun with friends and family while testing your focus, stamina, balance and agility.

Free Your Wild Side at the Virginia Aquarium

Get up close and personal with Virginia Beach's most beloved residents at the Virginia Aquarium & Marine Science Center. From the harbor seals who greet you at the entrance to the sea turtles and sharks that await you inside, you'll be able to explore a wilder side of Virginia Beach.

There are thousands of fish, corals, jellyfish and other marine wonders in 800,000 gallons of aquariums, 300 hands-on exhibits, live animal habitats, and our half-mile nature trail.

Want to see more? Take a Sea Adventures boat trip and see dolphins, pelicans, and other native wildlife. Or help work a trawl net to collect fish and invertebrates during an Ocean Collections trip. In the winter months, Sea Adventures trips head out in search of whales and migratory visitors to Virginia. Each trip is staffed by trained, knowledgeable Virginia Aquarium educators.
